The Sujata Krishna Fellowship for Research in Early Childhood Development honors the life of preschool teacher Sujata Krishna.

CRITERIA

The Sujata Krishna Fellowship was established to provide support for students enrolled in a program of graduate study in the in the Graduate School of Education at the University of California, Berkeley who are interested in pursuing research in cognitive development and early childhood education for young children ages 2 to 4 years. Applicants should provide evidence of a commitment to preparing for research in this area through appropriate coursework and apprenticeship experiences in research settings.

The award for academic year 2016-2017 will be \$1,000. To be considered for this award, please send a brief statement (no more than one page) explaining how your work fits the criteria and attach a resume or CV, and a current transcript.

Prospective recipients will be identified, screened and selected by the Fellowship Committee of the Graduate School of Education in accordance with award criteria and GSE procedures. Award notifications will be made by October 24, 2016.
