

The Tillery Fellowship Award

Call for Proposals – Due September 30, 2016

The Tillery Fellowship honors the memory of the late Dale Tillery, Dean of the Graduate School of Education from 1979-80, author of the community college section of the California Master Plan for Higher Education, and a leader in protecting access and multiple options for community college students.

CRITERIA

The Tillery Fellowship was established to support students enrolled in a graduate program in the GSE who have a career interest in teaching, leadership, and research in the **Community College System**. The fellowship will be awarded to a student aspiring to a leadership role or preparing for a position in the community college system.

The award for academic year 2016-2017 will be \$10,000. To be considered for this award, please send a brief statement (no more than one page) explaining how your work fits the criteria and attach a resume or CV, and a current transcript.

SELECTION

Prospective recipients will be identified, screened and selected by the Fellowship Committee of the Graduate School of Education in accordance with award criteria and GSE procedures. Award notifications will be made by October 24, 2016.
